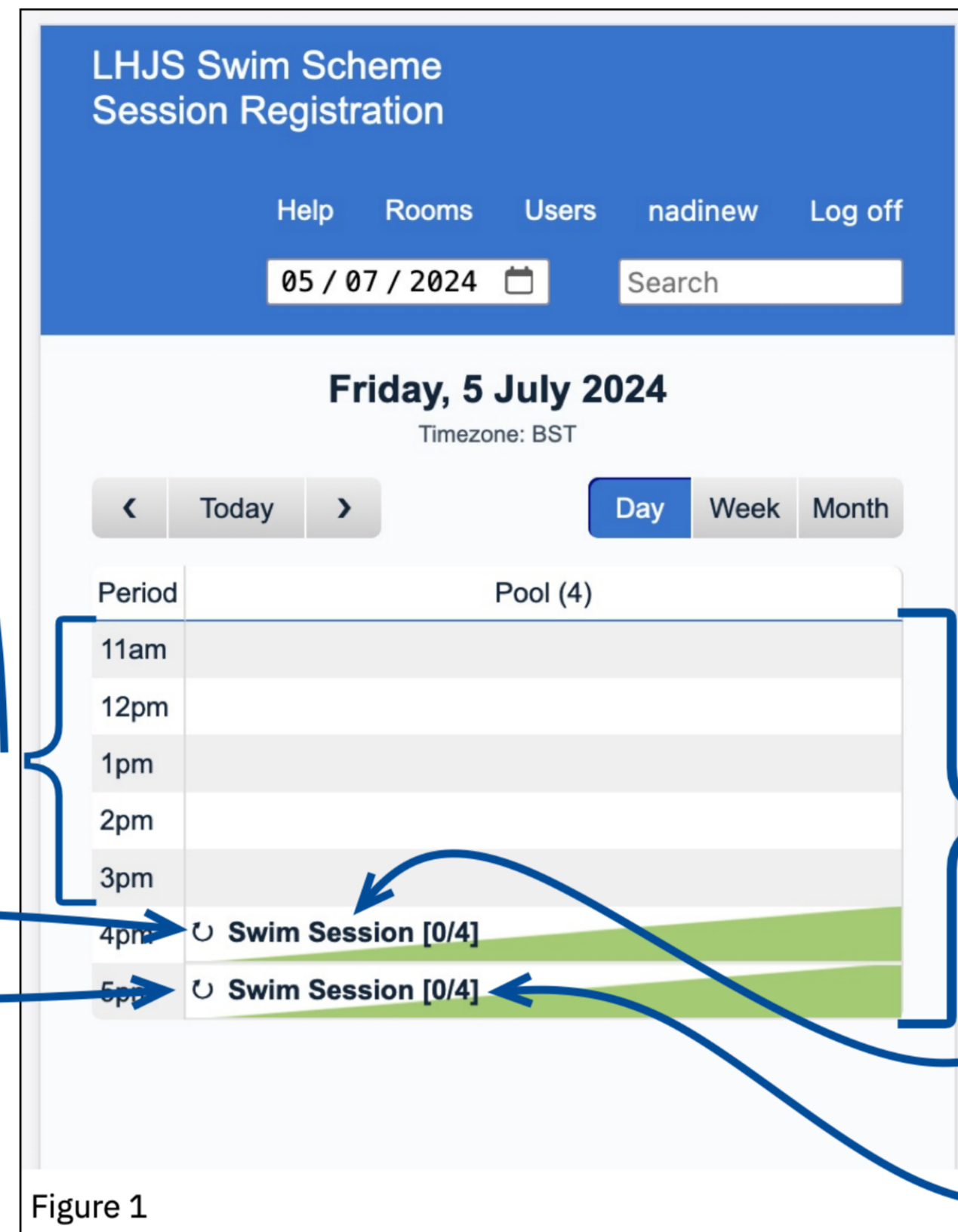


If you click or tap on a session that isn't available, you see the **Access denied** message.

To register for a Swim Session, you have to click or tap on an *available* session, i.e., on **Swim Session**.



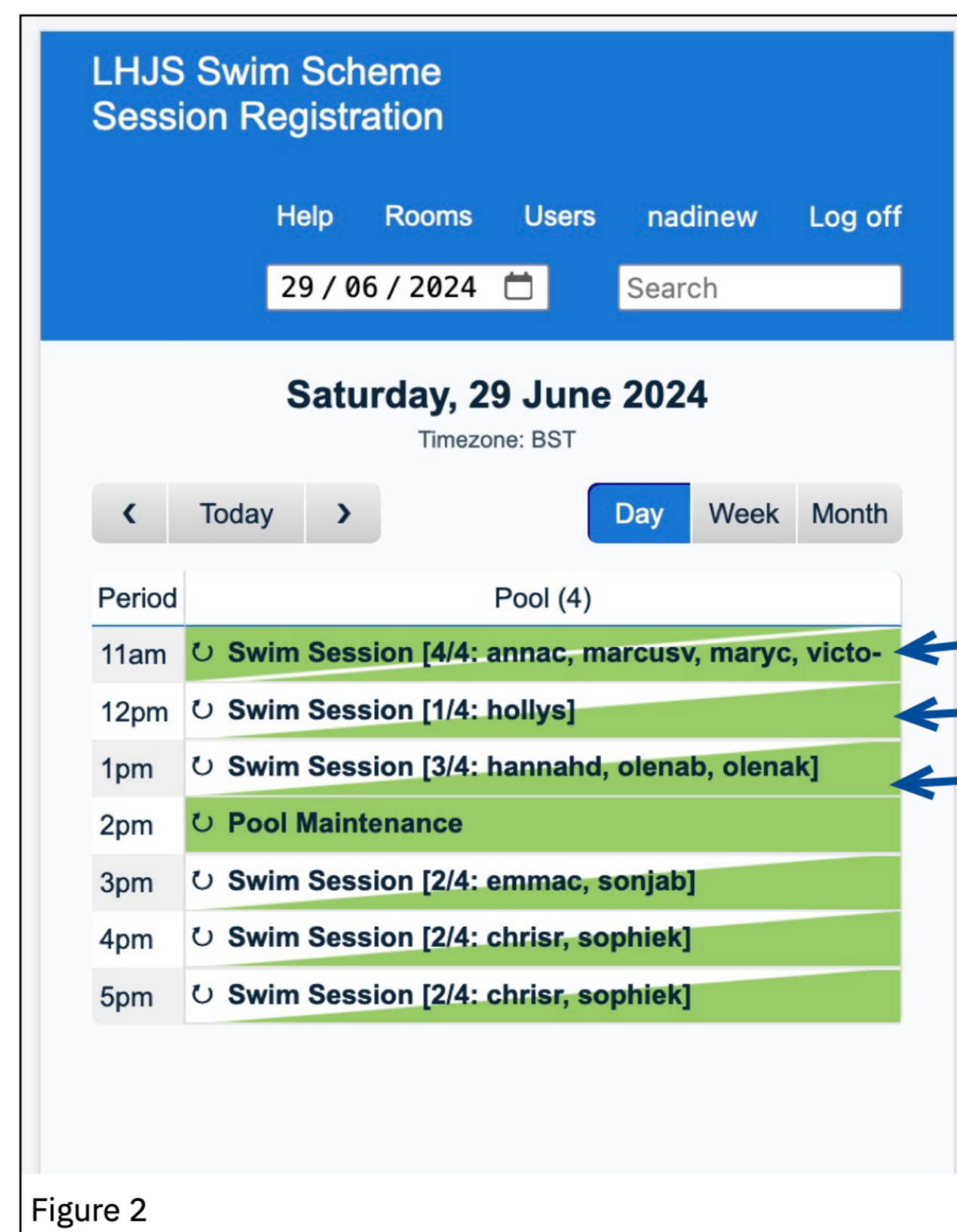
During term time, there are two slots available on Thursdays and Fridays and six on Saturdays.

In Figure 1, there are two sessions available. Nobody has registered for either session, which is indicated by the text **[0/4]**.

Every day is divided into 7 sessions, the first at 11am and the last at 5pm.

When the pool is available - on the days and at the times the school has said we can use the pool - you see **Swim Session** in the view of the day.

This is followed by 2 numbers inside square brackets. The first shows the number of people who have registered, the second shows the number of available registrations.



In Figure 2, there are six sessions available at 11am, 12pm, 1pm, 3pm, 4pm and 5pm. The slot at 2pm is reserved for the school to carry out their maintenance.

On the day shown, the 11am session is fully booked **[4/4]**, the 12pm has 3 slots available **[1/4]**, the 1pm slot has 1 slot available **[3/4]**, etc.
